To ensure your continued success and comfort with contact lenses, periodic follow-up progress exams are required.

First Fits include an initial fitting of the lens, a training session where the patient learns how to insert and remove the lens as well as proper care and handling of contacts, and follow up visits to ensure the contacts are being tolerated well. If the patient decides not to continue with contacts after the fitting and trial period, no fees will be collected. All contact lens prescriptions are valid 12 months from the date written.
