Today's Contact lens options are numerous. No longer are your choices simply a decision between hard or soft contacts. You may be a candidate for disposable lenses, astigmatic lenses, tinted lenses, bifocal lenses, rigid oxygen permeable lenses, hybrid lenses and more. The evolution of eye care technology is continually improving contact lens materials and lens care products to make them healthier, more comfortable, and more convenient to use.

Your Responsibilities

Contact lenses are safe and affordable when they are worn, fit, and cared for properly. Contacts are a medical device that must be specifically fit to your eyes. The privilege of wearing contacts will always require additional responsibility on your part. Please follow all of the outlined care procedures carefully. To ensure your continued success and comfort with contacts, periodic progress exams are required.

Contact lens prescriptions are valid for 12 months from the date written.

Vision Source of Amherst and Greenfield charges \$50 for a contact lens evaluation/fitting. Some vision plans may cover this service. Please let us know if you have a plan that covers the contact lens fitting.

The fee for a contact lens evaluation with a first time Multifocal, Toric, or Monovision fitting is \$85. This covers any necessary follow-ups and trial lenses. This fee applies if you currently wear contact lenses but have not been fitted for a multifocal, toric, or monovision lens with our office. This fee only applies if you finalize a prescription for the new modality.
